LEWIS CARDINAL

Lewis Cardinal is a communicator and educator. He has dedicated his work to creating and maintaining connections and relationships

that cross cultural divides. His work has mirrored his personal vision of a socially just and responsive society.

His long track record of public service includes Co-Chair of the Aboriginal Commission for Human Rights and Justice in Alberta and Trustee and Executive Board Member of the Council for a Parliament of World Religions, just to mention a few.

Lewis received Queen Elizabeth the Second's Diamond Jubilee Medal for Public Service, the IndSpire Award for Public Service (the highest award given to an Indigenous person by Indigenous people in Canada), the Province of Alberta's Centennial Medal for his work in Human Rights and Diversity and the Distinguished Alumni Award from Grant MacEwan University in Edmonton, Alberta.

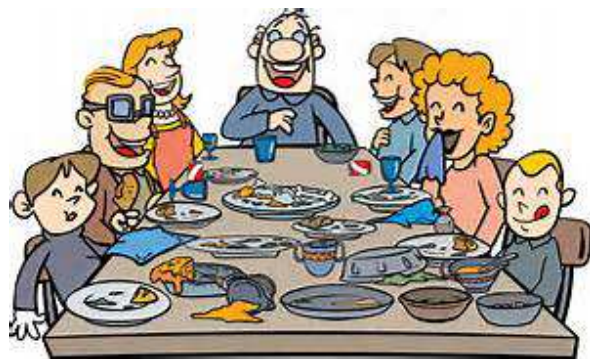
