Professor Emeritus of History and
Classics
University of Alberta

Rod MacLeod was born in Calgary. His University Education was: BA, University of Alberta, 1961, MA, Queen's University, 1967, and Ph D, Duke's University in 1971. He went through the ranks in the Department of History (and Classics) at the University of Alberta, 1969 - 2005 and served as Chair, Department of History 1980-1983 and as Associate Dean of Arts 1987-1988.

Rod is University of Alberta's official historian and wrote "All True Things: A History of the University of Alberta - 1908 - 2008. He is also the President of Edmonton's Aviation Museum.

Dr. MacLeod has been very interested in the History of Western Canada. He is the Author of (among other books and articles);

- The North West Mounted Police and Law Enforcement 1873 - 1905 - University of Toronto Press, 1975
- (with Bob Beal) Prairie Fire: the 1885 North West Rebellion - Hurtig Publishers, 1984
- All True Things: A History of the University of Alberta 1908 - 2008 - University of Alberta Press, 2008
- Sam Steele: A Canadian Life - University of Alberta Press, 2018
